

Interim Report of the Matching Fund Subcommittee to New York Quarterly Meeting, January 24, 2010

As of January 4, 2010, we have raised \$49,382.85 of our goal of \$67,000. In addition, we have a pledge of \$2000 from one donor. We have a matching fund pledge of \$2500 for donations made by members and attenders of Fifteenth Street Meeting between September 1, 2009, and April 1, 2010. We also expect to receive the \$13,500 remaining from the large matching grant with which we originally began this campaign. In order to receive the full amount of the matching funds, we need to raise an additional \$732 from members and attenders of that meeting. If we do so, we will have exceeded the \$67,000 goal by over \$1000. If we do not, then we need to raise \$274 from other sources in order to make up for the unrealized match and reach the \$67,000 goal.
